The **it's learning** Parent Engagement Dashboard allows schools to meet the 2010/2012 requirements for online reporting for parents.

Feature	Description
MIS integration	Available from Q2 2010.
Behaviour	Behaviour records – retrieved from <b>it's learning</b> or MIS.
Attendance	Attendance records – retrieved from <b>it's learning</b> or MIS.
Progress & attainment	Progress reports from the Individual Learning Plan, assessments and portfolios.
SEN	Information about special education needs – retrieved from <b>it's learning</b> or MIS.
Communication	Home-school communication via internal messaging or email. The communication is limited to the parents/carers and the child's teachers.
School information	Automatic information updates, such as news and school calendar.
Course information	Information about lesson plans, curriculum and homework.
Involvement	Tools for involving parents: polls, groups and projects
